Admission Process (*page 02*) provides an overview of the process involved in applying to The Hebrew Academy, and a calendar detailing when forms are due.

Application for Admittance (*page 03*) is the actual application where you record all the pertinent information relating to the applicant and his/her family. This form needs to be signed and returned with a \$100 check for new students applying to Toddler through Eighth grade.

Developmental History Report (*page 04*) to be submitted with Application for Admission for students T - 8th gr.

Confidential Recommendation Forms (*pages 05 and 06*) are school recommendation forms to be used for applicants either entering Pre-K - First Grade or Grades 2 – 8. These forms are filled out by the Principal/Early Childhood Director of your child's current school, or your child's current teachers.

Release of Records (*page 07*) is to be delivered to the current school your child attends. A copy of this form is submitted to The Hebrew Academy as well. It authorizes your child's current school to release all pertinent records to our school.

Tuition Schedule (*page 08*) provides all the information you need regarding tuition costs and payment options.

Financial Aid and Tuition Affordability Programs (*page 09*) delineates the different options available to make attending The Hebrew Academy possible for all families, regardless of financial ability.
